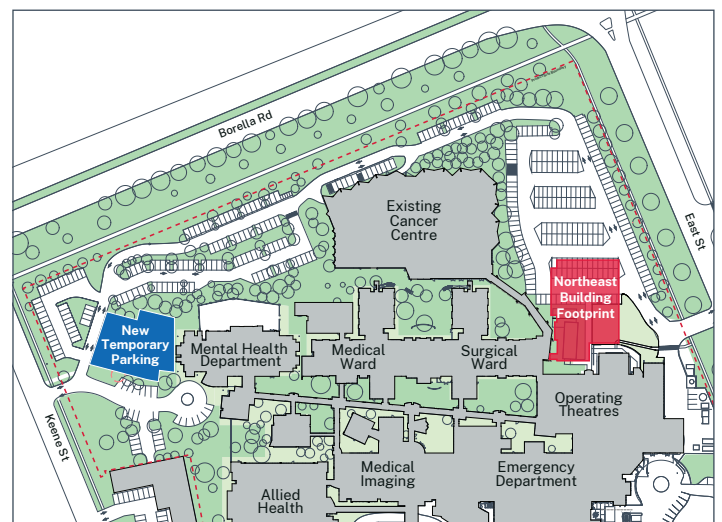
New Northeast Building designs

The new Northeast Building, will be built at the Albury Hospital campus as the first part of the Albury Wodonga Regional Hospital project. The 2-storey Northeast Building will support a range of health services and staff currently located in the Allied Health building that will be relocated to enable the construction of the new 7-storey Clinical Services Building.

The Northeast Building is also being built with the flexibility to provide opportunities for future service expansion. Work is expected to start on the Northeast Building this year, subject to planning approvals and appointment of a contractor.

New on-grade parking will also be provided to the northwest of the hospital campus to offset the impact of the new Northeast Building on existing parking. These new spaces will be available for staff, patients, and visitors before any changes are made to existing parking areas.

Albury Wodonga Regional Hospital project

The NSW, Victorian and Australian governments have committed \$558 million to the Albury Wodonga Regional Hospital project, one of the largest regional health projects currently underway in NSW and Victoria.

This project will:

- consolidate complex care on the one site
- deliver more beds, more car parking and access to state-of-the-art facilities
- double the existing floor space of the Albury Hospital Campus
- create a regional health hub with the existing health services on site.

Albury and Wodonga campuses

The transformation of the Albury Campus will bring all key complex care services onto one site. This will reduce the duplication of services and the need for urgent travel between the Wodonga and Albury Campuses, which improves patient safety. This paves the way for the Wodonga Campus to transform into an expanded non-emergency care hub for the community.



The project will deliver a mix of new and refurbished facilities and is expected to include:



2 new buildings, including a new 7-storey Clinical Services Building



New state-of-the-art Intensive Care Unit and operating theatres



Expanded and improved inpatient unit accommodation



Enhanced birthing, maternity and neonatal intensive care services



New expanded mental health unit



Improved landscaping throughout the site



Entry via Keene St with new drop-off and open garden areas



More car parking spaces
